How can Companies get involved?

There are 3 ways for companies to participate:

- 1. Run an interactive stand to pre-assigned groups of students there are 2 options:
 - Challenge Zone: 30 minute immersive challenge with groups of 10 students at a time
 - Insight Zone: 15 minute interactive stand with groups of 5 students at a time
- 2. Be an Ambassador: As a powerful role model, our industry ambassadors get assigned to a group of students, and their teacher, for the whole day, immersing yourself in the activities, workshops and challenges alongside the students. By chatting to the students throughout the day you will inform them of your job, career paths and inspir them along the way.
